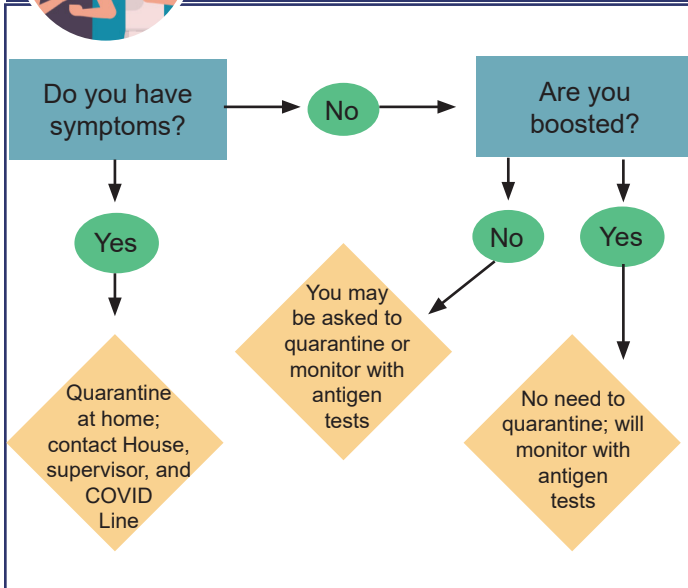


Residential Staff COVID Protocol

Quick Reference Guide



If You Have a Possible Exposure to COVID-19 (including household member)



If You Have Symptoms or Suspect You Have COVID

Call the House, your supervisor, and the COVID Line.

- If you have symptoms - you'll be excluded from work until symptoms resolve, as determined by the COVID Line
- If you are asymptomatic - your plan will be determined by the COVID Line.

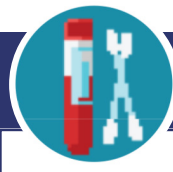
- **During Business Hours** - Coordinator completes COVID Worksheet
- **Outside of Business Hours** - House alerts Manager on Call who completes COVID worksheet

If House is in crisis need of staff, manager on call may consult with the Administrator on Call to determine if antigen tests can be used for mildly symptomatic staff.

Quarantine: Keeps someone with a possible exposure to COVID away from others - separating and restricting their movement to see if they become sick.



If You Test Positive For COVID-19

- Call the House, your supervisor, and the COVID Line.
- If you have symptoms, isolate at home until:
 - It's been 10 days since your positive test or the start of symptoms, whichever came first, **and**
 - You've been fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication, **and**
 - Your symptoms have improved.
 - Your supervisor clears you to return to your worksite.

If you test positive but do not have symptoms:

- Stay home until 10 days have passed since your positive test
- Test on day 4 & 5, or if mildly symptomatic on days 6 & 7. If both tests (taken 24 hours apart) are negative, you can return to work wearing a mask at all times until 10 days from positive test or first day of symptoms.
- If either test is positive, stay home for 10 days, returning when symptoms have improved **AND** you've been fever-free without the use of fever reducing medications for at least 24 hours.
- If you do develop symptoms, see above.

If a staff member receives positive results from an antigen test, they will follow-up with a PCR test within one week to confirm results.

- **During Business Hours** - Coordinator completes COVID Worksheet
- **Outside of Business Hours** - House alerts Manager on Call who completes COVID worksheet

Isolation: Keeps someone who is sick or has tested positive for COVID away from others, even in their own home.
