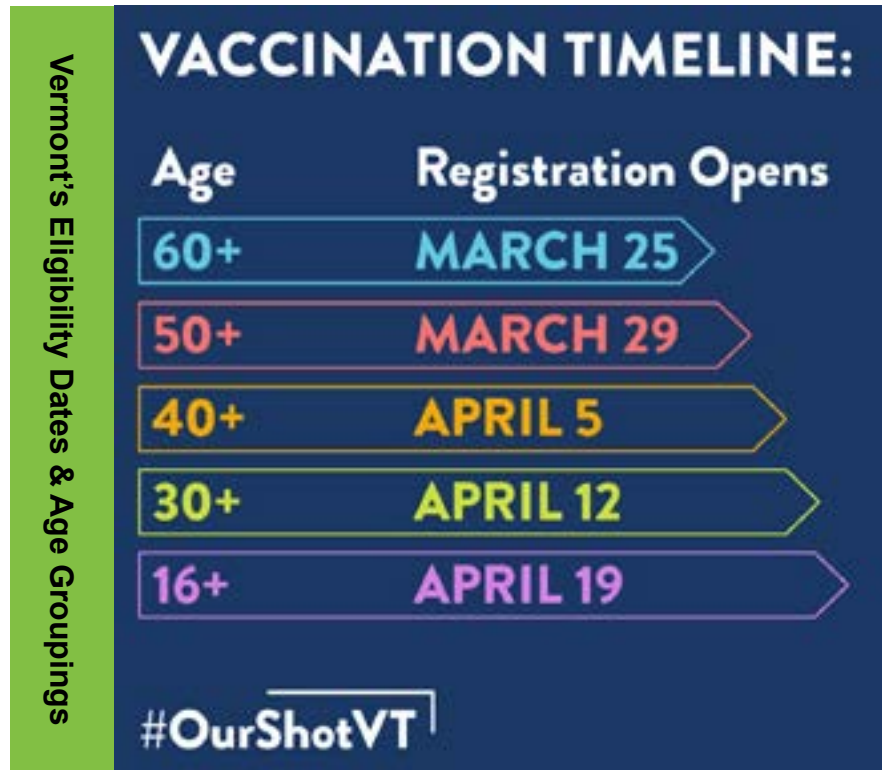


Vaccine Eligibility & Key Dates

Great news! Vermont has a timeline for when residents ages 16+ can sign up for their COVID-19 vaccine. And if enough Vermonters sign-up when their age group opens, the state could reach its goal to have Vermonters fully vaccinated as early as this July. That means we could start getting back to the places, people and things we love.

The quickest way to make an appointment is online at HealthVermont.gov/MyVaccine. The website also has helpful guidance and answers to commonly asked questions. If signing up online is not an option, you can also make an appointment by calling (855) 722-7878. Most Vermonters can expect the entire process, from registration to when the vaccine is most effective, to take about two months.



To Register:

- Visit HealthVermont.gov/MyVaccine or call (855) 722-7878.
- Follow the instructions to create an account and then log in.
- Choose an available location to schedule your appointment.
- Answer a few medical and demographic questions. You will also be asked for your insurance information, but this isn't required.
- Choose an available appointment time for the location and date you have selected.
- Get a confirmation email with your appointment details.
